



Artisan Information & Registration Form

APTN Indigenous Day Live (IDL) is the nation's largest event in recognition of National Indigenous Peoples Day. Through performances by multidisciplinary Indigenous artists, Canadians are brought together in celebration of Indigenous Peoples' unparalleled contributions to Canada.

Saturday, June 18, 2022 will mark the return to an in-person celebration for the first time since 2019. The live event will be free for all to attend. The broadcast will be aired on APTN's TV network and will be available via a free livestream.

Prior to the performances, attendees will be able to visit food vendors, enjoy cultural activations and browse the artisan market with handmade wares from Indigenous Canadian artisans.





Artisan Vendor Details

The artisan area will be located on the grounds of The Forks in proximity to the mainstage. Artisans will not be expected to bring a tent but will instead have a table and chairs available in a large market tent. You will have the opportunity to be part of a select group of Indigenous artisans to showcase your authentic handmade wares.

Authenticity guidelines

Vendor applications are reviewed by APTN to ensure authenticity. APTN reserves the right to decline any application which does not fall within these authenticity guidelines:

- Product must be hand-made or hand-crafted by an Indigenous person (in Canada, the term Indigenous Peoples refers to First Nation, Métis and Inuit Peoples)

Please note the following:

- Space is limited
- Power or wi-fi/internet won't be available (market tent will be lit for the evening)

Artisan fee - \$50

- Artisan spaces cannot be shared or transferred between two (2) artisans
- Additional services: if you require additional tables and/or chairs, there will be an additional cost of \$10/table and \$5/chair. This request must be made in advance.

Event times

- Saturday, June 18, 2022: 6 – 11 p.m.
- Set-up: Saturday, June 18, 2022 between 3 – 6 p.m.
 - Set-up must be completed by 6 p.m.
- Tear Down: between 11 – 11:30 p.m.
 - All booths must be removed from the area by 11:30 p.m.

Load-in/Unload

Exhibitors can load-in/unload between the Inn at the Forks hotel and the Children's Museum. You must go to IDL check-in to gain access to the site.

Security

APTN will have security throughout the celebration grounds. However, you are responsible for your products and other valuables at your booth space.

This may include wearing masks, vaccination or testing requirements. Any specific requirements will be provided to artisans in advance of the event, if necessary.
