



## Food Vendor Information & Registration Form

APTN Indigenous Day Live (IDL) is the nation's largest event in recognition of National Indigenous Peoples Day. Through performances by multidisciplinary Indigenous artists, Canadians are brought together in celebration of Indigenous Peoples' unparalleled contributions to Canada.

Saturday, June 18, 2022 will mark the return to an in-person celebration for the first time since 2019. The live event will be free for all to attend. The broadcast will be aired on all of APTN's linear channels and will be available via a free livestream.

Prior to the performances, attendees will be able to visit food vendors, enjoy cultural activations and browse the artisan market with handmade wares from Indigenous Canadian artisans.





## Food Vendor Details

The food vendors will be located on the grounds of The Forks in proximity to the mainstage. You will have the opportunity to be part of a select group of food vendors to sell your food and beverages.

### Please note the following:

- Space is limited.
- **There is absolutely no driving on The Forks property in unpermitted areas. You can be fined by The Forks Renewal Corporation if you are found liable.**
- **Food vendors are responsible for all of their equipment needs.**
- **All food vendors must provide their own cord covers and plywood for tires. No exceptions will be made.**

### Food vendor fee - \$350

- Food vendor spaces cannot be shared or transferred between two (2) vendors

### Event times

- Saturday, June 18, 2022: 6 – 11 p.m.
- Set-up: you will be provided with a set time for when you will be allowed on site. Times will be provided at a date closer to the event (plan for between 12 – 3 p.m.).
- Tear Down: between 11 p.m. – 12:00 a.m.
  - All food vendors must be removed from the area by 12:00 a.m.

### Load-in/Unload

Vendors can load-in/unload between the Inn at the Forks hotel and the Children's Museum. You must go to IDL check-in to gain access to the site.

### Security

APTN will have security throughout the celebration grounds. However, you are responsible for your products and equipment at your vendor space.
